

Tariff for Provisioning of Fibre Connections for Trial from a Designated Building MDF Room to a Designated Location (“Tariff Scheme”)

Key Terms and Conditions

NetLink Trust will provision fibre connections from a designated Building MDF Room to a designated location (“Trial Connections”) on the conditions that:

- The requestor shall procure that itself or its assigned contractor has entered a contract with a Requesting Licensee to provide the necessary fibre connection(s) originating from a data centre or Central Office and terminating at the designated Building MDF room.
- The requestor shall ensure that the Trial Connections shall not be used for any purpose other than for the trial (which has to be made known to NetLink Trust) at the point of signing up for this Tariff Scheme.
- All ducts through which NetLink Trust’s fibre cables are laid for the purpose of fulfilling the Trial Connections under the trial shall belong to NetLink Trust. The relevant ducts shall be assigned or transferred, without consideration, to NetLink Trust free and clear of any and all encumbrances with regard to title.
- The requestor shall facilitate NetLink Trust’s access to the designated locations selected for the trial.
- No service level guarantees shall apply to the Trial Connections provisioned under this Tariff Scheme.
- NetLink Trust shall be entitled to provision the Trial Connections under different terms and conditions upon expiry or termination of the Tariff Scheme.

Charges

No charges will be imposed by NetLink Trust for any of the Trial Connections provisioned during the term of this Tariff Scheme.

Term

The Tariff Scheme shall expire twelve (12) calendar months after the commencement date (i.e. date of which the first Trial Connection is provisioned by NetLink Trust), or upon the expiry or termination of the trial, whichever is later.
